2nd Vice President—"An active member shall be eligible for any office after they have been a member of the club for one year." (Membership Chairperson)

Secretary—"An active member shall be eligible for any office after they have been a member of the club for one year." (Duties: Keep accurate record of all meetings of the club and E-board and conduct all correspondence of the club.

Treasurer— "An active member shall be eligible for any office after they have been a member of the club for one year." (Duties: keep accurate account of all monies and make no payments except as authorized by the club or the E-Board.)

WOMAN ARTIST OF THE MONTH

Marlies Manning is a watercolor artist and landscape architect. She was born in Toronto, Canada, raised in Wisconsin, then moved to Michigan at the end of high school. She completed her B.S. in Land Use Analysis from Eastern Michigan University, and then received her B.L.A. in Landscape Architecture from Michigan State University, graduating with High Honors. Marlies worked as a landscape architect in Kalamazoo and Detroit before moving to Big Rapids in 2000 to start her own firm, Manning Design.

Art has been part of her life and her vocation as a landscape archi-

tect. After a 33 year career in landscape architecture and owning her own business, she is focusing her time and energy on watercolor painting.

As an artist, she enjoys many different art mediums, including mosaic, fiber arts, and weaving. However, watercolor has intrigued her and challenged her the most. Working with water and pigment creates fascinating and sometimes unpredictable results. Watercolor art can feel dreamy and mystical, or it can be photo-realistic.

Marlies' inspirations are drawn from her hikes in the woods, along shorelines, and from the local rural scenery. She especially enjoys painting weathered wood, fields, and landscapes that are ubiquitous in the rural area she lives in. The history of small family farms is disappearing as the weathered structures melt into the ground. Her intent is to honor the past, but also to draw attention to the preciousness of open space and the natural environment.

Marlies has exhibited her work, in partnership with a fellow artist, in shows at the 515 Gallery in Clare, Artworks in Big Rapids, and the Ferris State University fine art gallery. Her watercolor, "Playing in the Muskegon" shown below, has been accepted in the Great Northern Art Explosion in Graying, an international fine arts show. Her work is currently available through Artworks in Big Rapids and Artsplace in Fremont.
