Sue Bean was selected as GFWC-Big Rapids Woman of Achievement for 2023 because of her volunteerism and achievements in the club and the community. She was selected as 2017 Clubwoman of the Year; has been the Health and Wellness Community Service Program Chair for several years; Board Member and volunteer for the Manna Food Pantry for four years, has served on the Big Rapids Township Board of Review for five years, current Election Inspector and past Election Chair for Big Rapids Township; and both Board member and current Treasurer for St. Mary/St. Paul Ministry and volunteer for 20 plus years which is a resale store where 100% of the profit goes back into the community in the form of housing assistance, utility assistance, etc.

Sue is involved with the club's Suitcases for Foster Care Children Program, the Adopt-a-Family Christmas program for the women's shelter, the club's annual yard sale with proceeds going back into the community, and has attended state and district GFWC meetings as well.

The past volunteer opportunities for Sue include being a ten year Board member for WISE, Inc. (Women's Information Services, Inc.) which is the local domestic violence women's shelter; 10 year Board member for City of Big Rapids Planning Commission; and also has served on the GFWC-Big Rapids Executive Board.

Sue has been married for 47 years and has four daughters and nine grandchildren, has been a realtor for 21 years and is a lifetime member of St. Mary/St. Paul Catholic Church. She has achieved at lot and is truly living the volunteer spirit.

WOMAN ARTIST OF THE MONTH (provided by the Arts & Culture CSP)

SUSAN KRUSZYNSKI



Dr. Susan Kruszynski is an award-winning art quilt designer, teacher, and gallery artist. She has over 50 years of experimentation with fabrics to produce colorful artistic creations. She started landscape fiber art design with collage art quilts in 2014. By hand cutting, collaging, pressing, and machine stitching pieces of fabric together, she creates art quilts that look like paintings. A native of Michigan, her works are often inspired by the trees and woodlands along the Lake Michigan shoreline. She currently resides in Muskegon, Michigan. Besides creating her quilt art, she also teaches quilting classes, markets her fiber art at shows and exhibitions, and runs her Quilting Fabrics in Time business. She recently retired from Muskegon Community College as a literary specialist. Susan placed in the top 25 in the Grand Rapids ArtPrize Nine in 2017 and was

1st place in the Grand Haven Lighthouse Quilt Guild Show in 2018 and 2019. Pieces of her quilt art can be purchased at Artworks in Big Rapids.
